

SPESE Student and Adjunct Instructor Scholarship Award Submission Guidelines

Award:

The Southeast region of SPE would like to offer three scholarships of \$500 each plus the member's conference registration fee for the National Conference in Dallas, Texas, March 26-29, 2009. One will be awarded to an undergraduate student, one to a graduate student, and one to an Adjunct Instructor. The winners will be invited to present their work at the next SPESE regional conference in the fall 2009. (optional)

Award winners will be announced and contacted by February 11, 2009 and the winners will be posted on the regional website: www.spese.org. The awards will be in the form of a check to be presented to the winners at the Southeast Regional Members Meeting at the National Conference in Dallas, Texas. Attendance at this meeting is required for the award winners.

Juror Stan Strembicki:

Stan Strembicki is a Professor of Art and senior faculty in the digital imagining & photography program in the college of art at Washington University. He teaches classes in the graduate and undergraduate photography major as well as photo I to elective students. His work ranges from a large project photographing the last 17 Mardi Gras's in New Orleans; staged, narrative figure studies; urban landscape photographs of Italy since 1989; and his most recent work involves a 2 year project photographing Post Katrina New Orleans. Stan has been a member of SPE since 1978 and he was the founder of the SPE student scholarship award for the Midwest Region.

Eligibility:

- All student applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student in a 2 or 4 year undergraduate or graduate program within the Southeast SPE Region.
- All adjunct applicants must teach at a 2 or 4 year program within the southeast SPE Region. Applicants do not have to be a current member to apply. However, all award recipients must become a member at his or her own cost for 2009.

Applicant Requirements:

Applications must be emailed to Rebecca Nolan, rnolan@scad.edu by the deadline listed above. The subject of the email must state Undergraduate Applicant, Graduate Applicant or Adjunct Applicant.

Student

- 10 Images of recent work
- Include a word document identification page listing full name, graduate student, undergraduate student or Adjunct Instructor, email, phone, mailing address, institution affiliation. This document should also include Image Identification matching the images submitted with title, process, size, and date for each image submitted.
- A cover letter indicating what scholarship you are applying for, why you are applying, and a description of any previous involvement in SPE (no longer than one page).
- A scan of current student/faculty ID

Adjunct

- All materials listed above plus a 1-2 page current CV

Image Guidelines: All images JPG format, size 72ppi, longest dimension no more than 1024 pixels. Please title each image with number corresponding to identification page, underscore, last name, underscore, title. (example: 01_Lastname_title_jpg)
